



EVENTS & ACHIEVEMENTS 2024-2025

The academic year 2024-2025 was filled with numerous events and achievements. Below is a detailed report of the year's major events.



1. Teacher's Animation:

A two-day Animation program was conducted for the teachers of DBS Rajanagar at **DBS Galenja** to ensure teaching methodologies, improving classroom management and fostering a dynamic learning environment on **3rd and 4th of May 2024**. 
12. School Annual Sports Day:
